IMAGINEFICTIONAL ARCHITECTURE AND THE LIBERATION OF IDEAS

Liberated from convention, fictional architecture becomes an idea which can explore new formal languages, develop idealised structures, form spatial concepts, tell stories and generate atmospheres. By not aiming to influence the built environment, the architectural drawing unfolds its potential to communicate what has so far merely been imagined.
